## Access

These hills are managed & farmed by various groups & individuals. Generally there is a tradition of walking access on the open moorlands but walkers have a responsibility to follow the Country Code and not abuse this tradition. Lands marked as Coillte and National Park lands have an open access policy. Hillwalking Access points shown on this map are indications of routes onto or off the open hills that have been used by many generations of hillwalkers. The depiction of a road, track or path does not necessarily indicate a public right of way. If in doubt, ask locally, if possible.
